# North Atlantic Treaty Organisation to Establish Northern Land Command in Eastern Finland

- The North Atlantic Treaty Organisation (NATO) will set up a new land command in eastern Finland, near the Russian border, in 2025.
- This command will oversee land force operations in northern Europe during military conflicts.
- The decision comes after Finland joined NATO in 2023 in response to Russia's invasion of Ukraine in 2022.
- Finland is organizing NATO's presence on its territory.
- Unit Designation: The new unit will be known as the Multi Corps Land Component
   Command and will operate under NATO's Norfolk Joint Force Command based in the United States.



- The oath was administered by Lieutenant Governor Vinai Kumar Saxena at the Raj Niwas, the LG's secretariat.
- He Succeeded Justice Satish Chandra Sharma.



# Sunita Williams Assumes Command of the International Space Station for the 2nd Time

- National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) astronaut Sunita
   Williams has assumed command of the International Space Station
   (ISS), marking her second stint as the station's leader.
- She previously served as commander during Expedition 33 in 2012.

## **Key Highlights:**

- Current Mission Details: Williams, along with fellow astronaut Butch Wilmore, has been aboard the ISS since June 5, 2024, after launching on Boeing's Starliner spacecraft, which marked its first crewed flight.
- Their mission was initially planned for eight days but has been extended to February 2025 due to technical issues with the Starliner.
- NASA's Future Plans: NASA is preparing a SpaceX Crew Dragon spacecraft for an early 2025 mission to safely return Williams and Wilmore to Earth.







# Indian Railways Triumphs Over IOC in 95th MCC-Murugappa Gold Cup Final

- Indian Railways emerged victorious with a 5-3 win over Indian Oil Corporation (IOC) in the final of the 95th MCC-Murugappa Gold All-India Hockey Tournament.
- A large crowd **applauded the defending champions, Railways**, as they completed a lap of honour after the match.
- Railways dominated the tournament, and in the final, they prevented IOC, which included former Olympians and international players, from gaining control.

- The 8th edition of the India-Kazakhstan Joint Military Exercise KAZIND-2024 began on September 30, 2024, at the Surya Foreign Training Node in Auli, Uttarakhand.
- The exercise is scheduled to take place from September 30 to October 13,
   2024.
- KAZIND has been conducted annually since **2016**, promoting military cooperation between India and Kazakhstan.
- The last exercise was held in Otar, Kazakhstan, from October 30 to November
   11, 2023.





# **Ishpreet Singh Chadha Makes History in Pro Snooker Circuit**

- Ishpreet Singh Chadha, hailing from Mumbai, recently achieved a remarkable milestone by reaching the quarterfinals of the professional snooker circuit, defeating the legendary Mark Selby, a four-time World Snooker champion.
- This victory marks a significant achievement for Chadha, as he becomes the first Indian in 10 years to advance to a pro semifinal at one of the four Home Nations majors.



# **International Day of Non-Violence 2024: October 2**


- The International Day of Non-violence is observed on the 2nd October of every year.
- In 2004, Iranian Nobel laureate Shirin Ebadi had a proposal of an International Day of Non-Violence.
- This idea was gradually attracted by some leaders of India's Congress Party.
- In January 2007, they called upon the United Nations to adopt the idea.
- On 5th June 2007, the UN General Assembly adopted the resolution and established the International Day of Non-Violence.
- The International Day of Non-Violence is observed on 2nd October in order to commemorate the birth anniversary of the Non-violent freedom fighter Mohandas Karmchand Gandhi.





# Gandhi Jayanti 2024: October 2

- Gandhi Jayanti is celebrated in India to commemorate the birth anniversary
  of the freedom fighter Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi, also known as
  Mahatma Gandhi.
- This day is celebrated on 2nd October of every year as he was born on 2nd October 1869.
- This day is one of the national holidays in India.
- Mahatma Gandhi is also called the "Father of The Nation.





- The government launched the PM E-DRIVE Scheme, aimed at promoting the adoption of electric vehicles (EVs) in India.
- The initiative comes with an outlay of Rs 10,900 crore, focusing on setting up charging infrastructure and developing the EV manufacturing ecosystem in the country.
- The scheme will run until March 31, 2026.

# Surgeon Vice Admiral Arti Sarin appointed as the first female Director General of the Armed Forces Medical Services

- Surgeon Vice Admiral Arti Sarin has become the first woman officer to take over as the Director General of Armed Forces Medical Services (DGAFMS).
- The DGAFMS is responsible for overseeing medical policy matters related to the Indian Armed Forces and operates under the Ministry of Defence.






- India's maiden mission to Venus, which is scheduled for launch in March 2028, will embark on a 112-day journey to reach the planet.
- The ₹1,236-crore Venus Orbiter Mission (VOM) was recently approved by the Union Cabinet and the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) on October 1, 2024 revealed the targeted launch window for the mission.
- According to the targeted launch window for VOM, the

Earth departure date is scheduled on March 29, 2028, and the arrival date on Venus is July 19, 2028. VOM will be launched by the Launch Vehicle Mark-3 (LVM-3).

## What is ISRO's Venus Orbiter Mission (VOM)?

- The Venus Orbiter Mission (VOM) is unofficially referred to as Shukrayaan.
- Mission Focus: The primary aim of VOM is to explore Venus's atmosphere and geology.
- It will gather crucial scientific data on the thick atmosphere of Venus.







# National Payments Corporation of India to create UPI-style payment system for Trinidad and Tobago

- The overseas arm of India's National Payments Corporation of India
   (NPCI) will build a digital payments system for Trinidad and Tobago, modelled after India's United Payments Interface (UPI).
- The NPCI International Payments Limited (NIPL) signed a deal with the Ministry of Digital Transformation of Trinidad and Tobago to build a digital payments system modelled after India's Unified Payments Interface (UPI) for person-to-person (P2P) and person-to-merchant (P2M) transactions.
- Earlier in 2024, NIPL had agreed to develop digital payments systems for **Peru** and **Namibia**, using UPI as a blueprint.





- Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan inaugurated India's first supercapacitor manufacturing facility at Keltron Component Complex Limited (KCCL) in Kallyassery, Kannur, on October 1, 2024.
- The supercapacitor manufacturing plant was developed in collaboration with the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO).

# Inauguration of India's First Compressed Biogas Facility in Ranchi


- Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the first compressed biogas

# **Union Cabinet Approves Classical Language**

### **Status for Five Languages**

- The **Union Cabinet**, chaired by Prime Minister **Shri Narendra Modi**, has approved the conferment of **Classical Language status** to **Marathi**, **Pali**, **Prakrit**, **Assamese**, and **Bengali**.
- This initiative aims to recognize these languages as custodians of India's profound cultural heritage.

### **Key Details and Background**

• Initiation: The Government of India first declared a Classical Language category on 12th October 2004 by designating Tamil as a Classical Language.

### **Criteria for Classical Language Status:**

- High Antiquity: Recorded history of over 1,000 years.
- Valuable Heritage: A body of ancient literature/texts that has historical significance.
- **Original Literary Tradition**: The literary tradition must be unique, not borrowed from other languages.

The following languages have been conferred **Classical Language status**:

- The event will feature participation from leading Indian and foreign manufacturers and several delegations from friendly foreign countries.
- Many fighter aircrafts and helicopters performed on air and a defence exhibition was inaugurated by PM Narendra Modi.
- IAF's Tejas aircraft which is a lightweight, highly agile and multi-role supersonic fighter was a major highlight

in the aero India show in 2023.

# India, Nepal and Bangladesh Sign Trilateral Agreement for Electricity Export

- India, Nepal and Bangladesh have entered into a trilateral agreement that enables the export of 40 megawatts of electricity from Nepal to Bangladesh via India's power grid.
- This landmark deal, signed in Kathmandu, marks the first instance of Nepal selling electricity to Bangladesh, as it has previously only exported power to India.

- The Indian U-17 football team clinched the SAFF(South Asian Football)
   Federation) Men's U-17 Championship 2024 by defeating Bangladesh in the final match.
- The tournament was held at the Changlimithang Stadium in Thimphu,

- India maintained an unbeaten record throughout the competition, showcasing strong performances in both attack and defence.



- It will be the **first visit to Pakistan by an Indian EAM in 9 years;** the last visit was by Sushma Swaraj in 2015 for the Heart of Asia Ministerial Conference on Afghanistan that was held in Islamabad on December 8-9, 2015.

Pakistan's Role:Pakistan is the current rotating chair of the Shanghai Cooperation
 Organisation (SCO) CHG and has extended invitations to all member states, including
 Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

# India elected to GlobE Steering Committee to tackle global corruption

- India has been elected to the 15-member steering committee of the GlobE
   Network during a plenary session in Beijing.
- The election followed a multi-stage voting process, allowing India to actively contribute to global efforts in combating corruption and asset recovery.

### **About GlobE Network:**

- The Global Operational Network of Anti-Corruption Law Enforcement Authorities (GlobE Network) was launched under the G20 framework to address international corruption and financial crimes.
- Officially launched on June 3, 2021, during the UN General Assembly Special
   Session against Corruption.
- The network currently has **121 member countries and 219 member** authorities, with India being a member.
- India's Participation in the Network: India's Central Bureau of Investigation
   (CBI) and Enforcement Directorate (ED) are part of the GlobE Network.
